



National Championships Policy

National events include any event where WSWC awards the rights to a local organizing committee, this includes regional and national championships. The guidelines listed below are designed to ensure these events are managed effectively and efficiently.

GENERAL

1. All bids coming before Congress must comply with the application requirements outlined in the WSWC Hosting Guidelines in order to be considered.
2. A contract/agreement must be signed by the Host Organizing Committee and WSWC, before the HOC can stage the event. The Host Organizing Committee, Provincial Association, and Water Ski and Wakeboard Canada must be signatories on the Agreement.
3. The Executive Board is empowered to approve Hosting Guidelines and Agreements for national level events.
4. WSWC retain all boat, television, marketing rights to all national events.

WATER SKI

1. When funds are available, to fund athlete travel expense, by province, to the Canadian Water Ski Championships, based on a funding formula that;
 - travel funding for Sport Canada carded athletes is taken off the top,
 - the remaining funds are divided / province based on a formula that accounts for at least one athlete / province, distance from the site, and number of current year competitive license holders, as of the date of the national Championships,
2. When possible, schedule the Canadian Water Ski Championships during the same dates as the US Water Ski Championships.

WAKEBOARD

1. The maximum entry fee is \$100 / competitor.
